Application – 2010 Community Supported Agriculture Season

Double Oak Farm CSA Program: *We plan to offer one long season of production beginning with limited varieties of greens, radishes and other early season crops, expanding in full summer to a wide variety of vegetables and melons, and extending through the late fall into more cool weather crops. Double Oak Farm will follow the CSA model that is in common usage today -- as a shareholder, you are purchasing a share of everything that is grown on the farm. You are also sharing in the risks inherent in farming. We cannot guarantee a certain size allotment each week or even that we will provide certain specific vegetables. All shares are not created equal – early and late season shares will be less varied and abundant than high season shares, but on average we will strive to provide good value for the shareholders.*

The produce you receive will be naturally grown using approved organic methods -- no unapproved pesticides, no unapproved fertilizers, no unapproved herbicides, and no genetically modified seed will be used. Please note, however, that ACLT is not certified under the National Organic Program and that some nonorganic seed may be used. Produce will be available for weekly pick up at Double Oak Farm either on Wednesday afternoon or Saturday morning.
