Much of the land ACLT has preserved over the past 30 years was once tobacco farmland. Double Oak Road, located off of Dares Beach Rd in Prince Frederick, is now home to ACLT's office, the North Side Trailhead, and ACLT's Double Oak Farm.

Run and managed by ACLT's amazing volunteers, **Double Oak Farm uses the most environmentally friendly and sustainable farming methods** and dedicates a portion of the farm to an experimental/educational garden.

ACLT's Double Oak Farm **donates more than 75% of its harvest to St. John Vianney's food pantry**, which meant more than 4,000lbs of fresh, naturally grown fruits and vegetables in 2015.

The remainder of the produce is made available for public purchase at ACLT's 2nd Sunday Farmers Markets held throughout the summertime.
